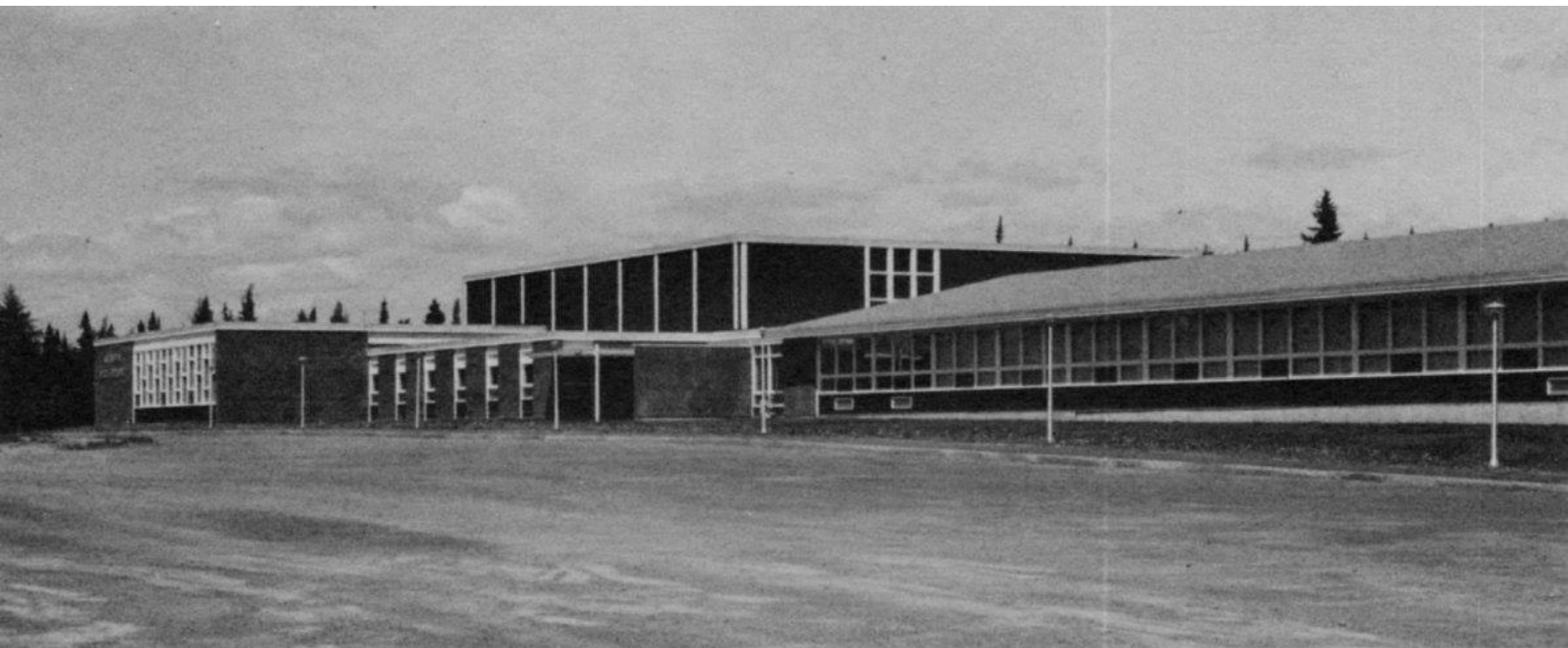
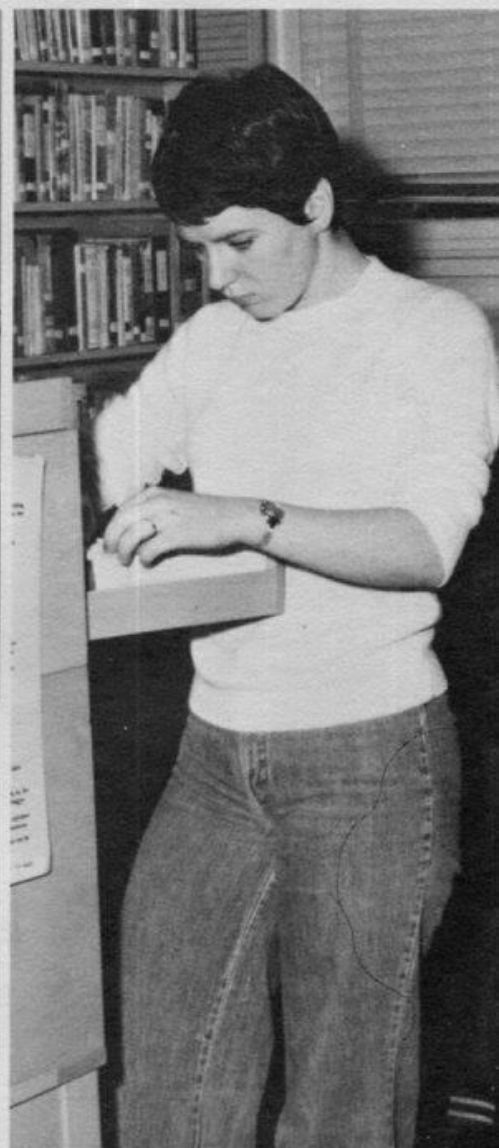
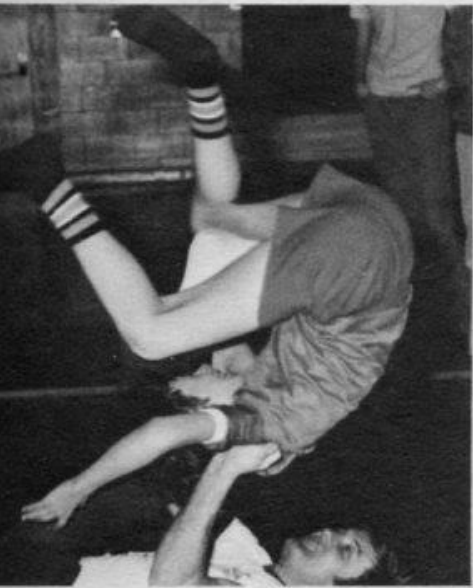

As the country goes forward looking for ways to make the next 200 years as memorable as the past 200, we feel confident that you can be an important part of it.

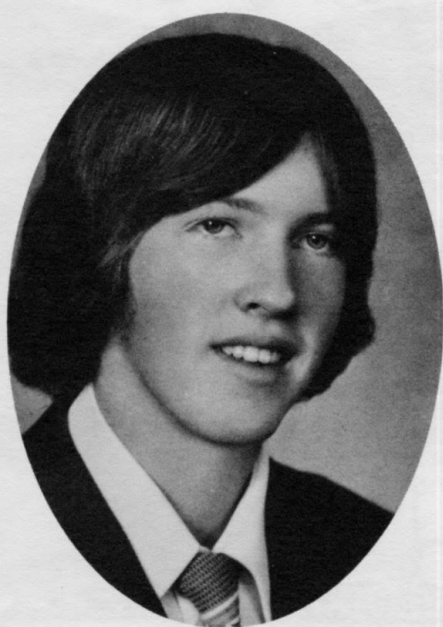

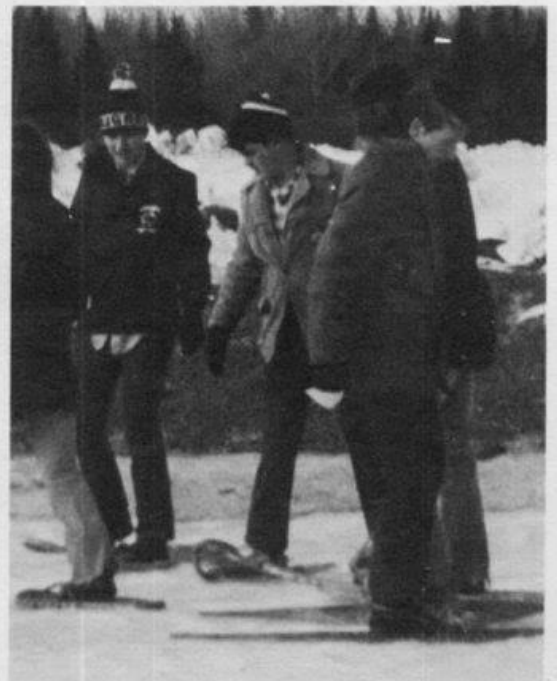


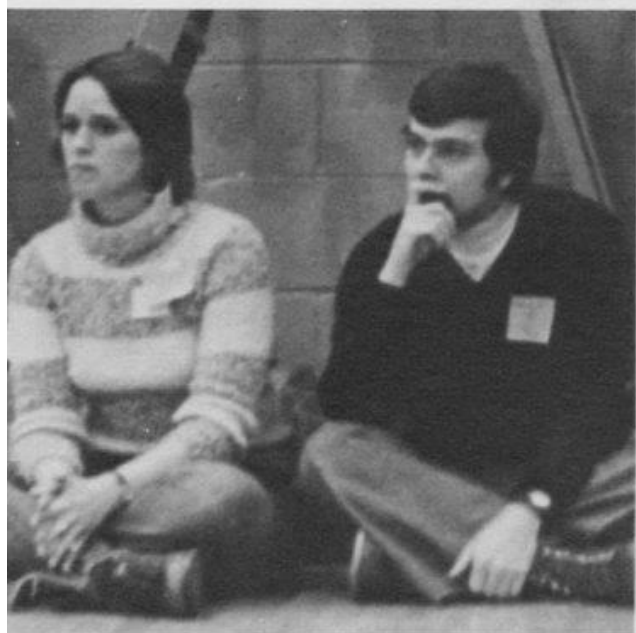
Cougar Festival
