Between all of our friends.

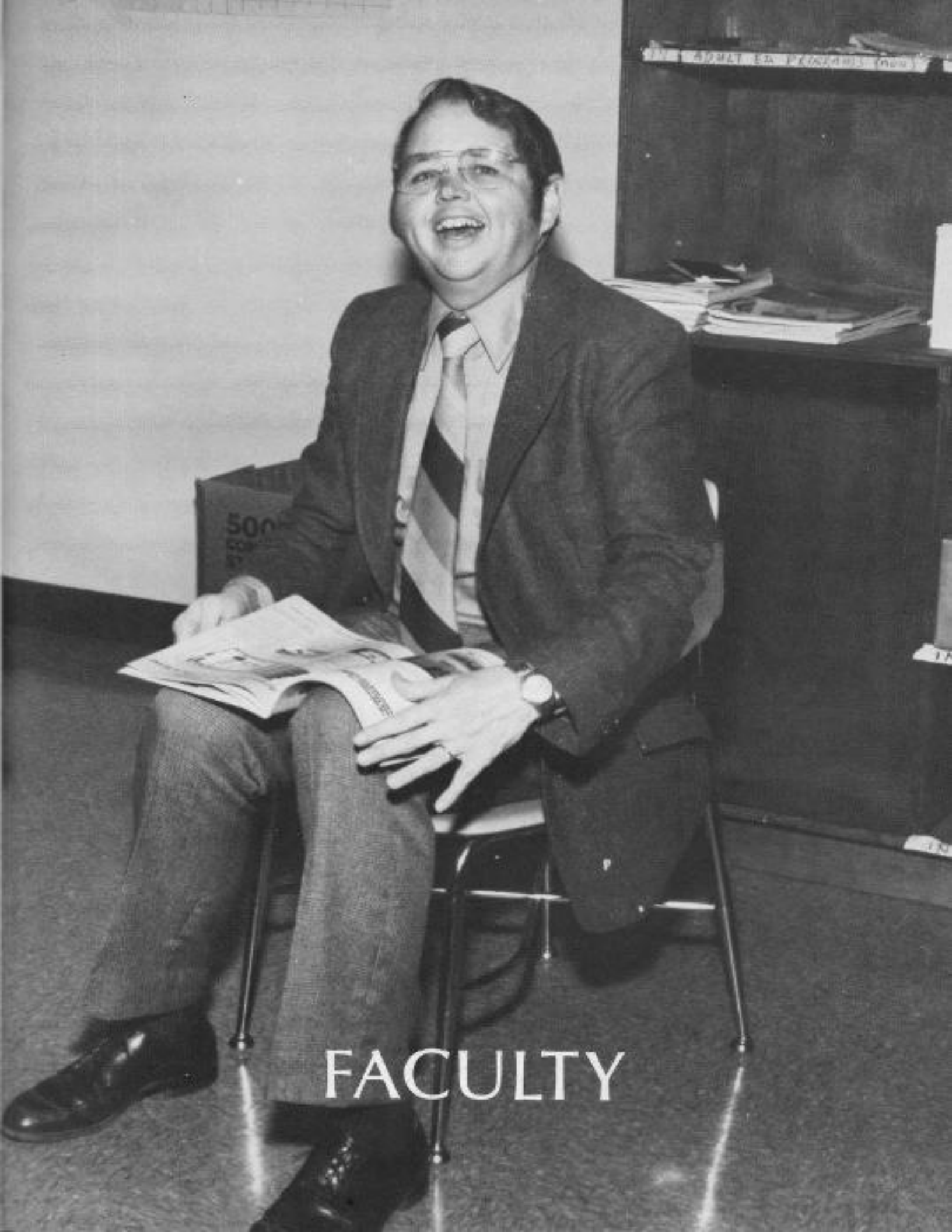
Like all the reports assigned

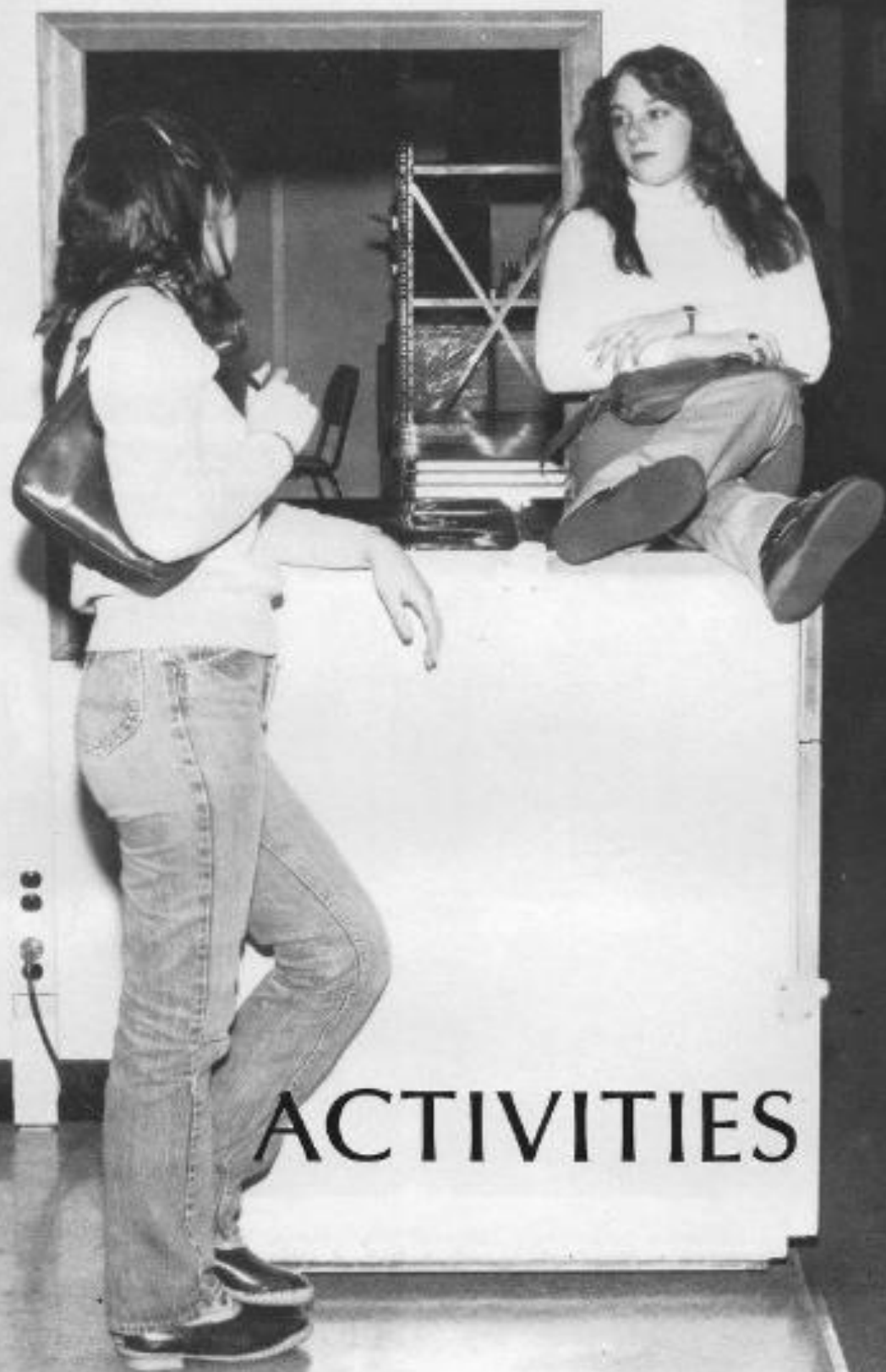
