The class of 1969 is to be congratulated on reaching an important plateau in your lives - graduation from high school.

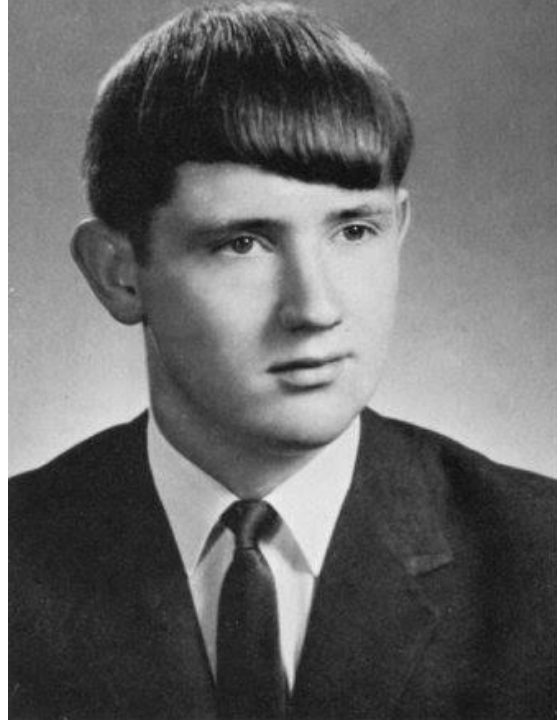
