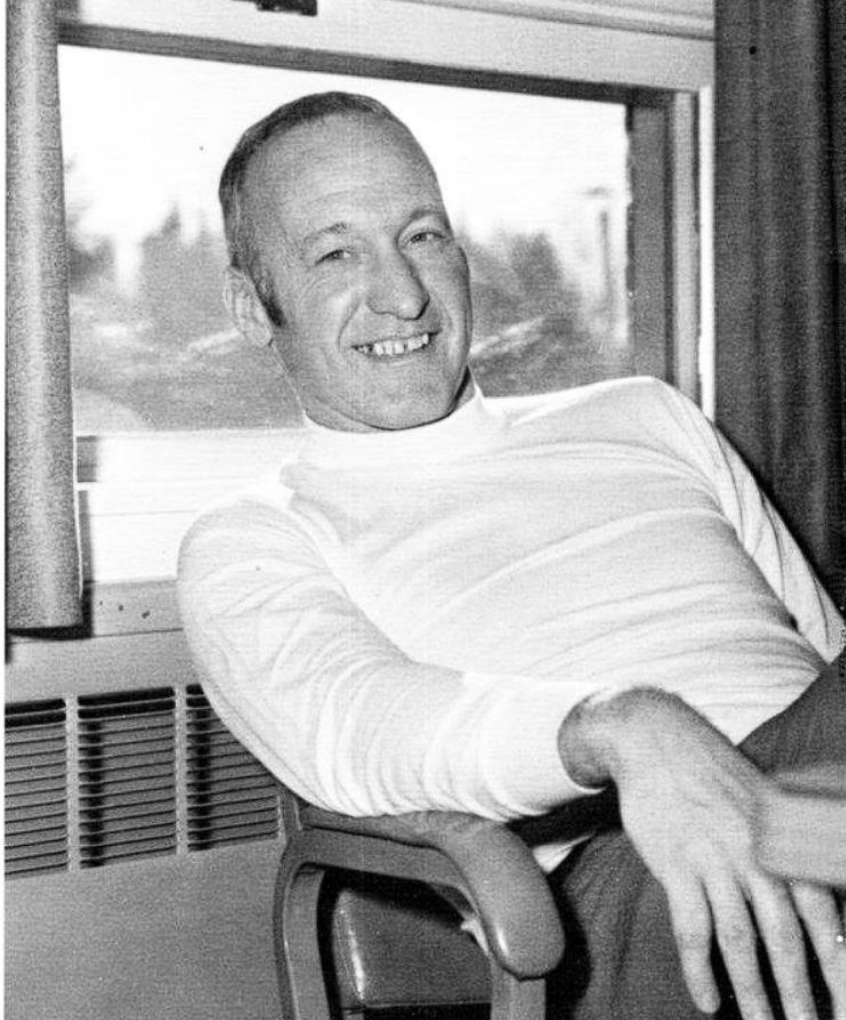
### Superintendents Message

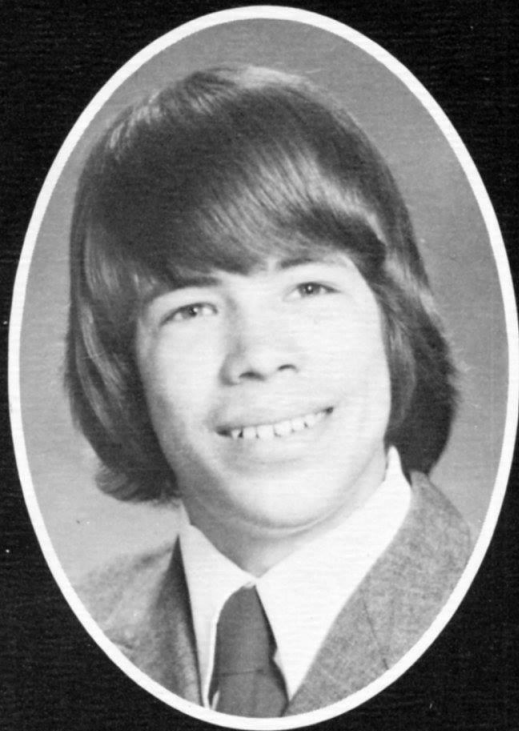
### Principal's Message
